Important information

Systems and Communication

We’re aware that a number of our systems – including those related to school meal services and communication platforms such as My Child at School – have not been functioning as expected. Please be assured that this issue has been escalated to the highest level to resolve them. This is not the start to the term we had hoped for in terms of communication.

We understand that parents and carers are keen to pick up their children promptly, but the safety of our pupils remains our top priority, along with being respectful neighbours to our local community. Punctuality

Over the past three days, there have been nearly 100 instances of pupils arriving late to school, causing significant disruption to lessons and a loss of valuable learning time. This level of lateness affects not only those who are late but also the learning of others in the classroom. To address this issue, starting next week, any pupil who arrives late will be required to make up for lost learning by staying 20 minutes after school the following day.
