Trust Review – What It Means for Our School

We were pleased to welcome colleagues from the Trust into school this week as part of a review of our work. These reviews are an important part of how we ensure we are providing the very best for our students, helping us to recognise what is working well and where we can continue to improve.

The review identified many strengths across the school. Safeguarding was found to be effective, with a strong culture where students feel safe and know who to speak to if they have concerns. Reviewers also highlighted the positive relationships between staff and students, and the strong sense of community within the school.

Our students were praised for being polite, articulate and engaged in their learning. The nurturing environment we are building was recognised, alongside the wide range of opportunities we offer through enrichment, leadership and personal development programmes such as Lyfta. We were also pleased that our work with families and our open, supportive approach were noted as key strengths.

As with any review, there are areas for us to develop further. These include continuing to strengthen consistency in areas such as behaviour and attendance, developing our careers provision, and ensuring that all of our school systems work closely together to support students' progress and wellbeing. While there is much to be proud of, we recognise that there is always more to do. Consistency is particularly important—our aim is that every child's experience in school is a positive one, and that every parent's experience reflects this too. We know we do not always get it right, and there will never be perfection, but we are committed to making this the norm.

A key part of this work is strengthening how we engage with parents and carers. We are pleased to be launching a new SEND Forum, with the first meeting taking place on 19 June. This will provide an opportunity for families to share their views, contribute to our ongoing development work and work in partnership with us to support students with additional needs.

Over the coming months, we look forward to sharing our key priorities for the next academic year with you, so that you have a clear understanding of our focus and how this will benefit your children.

Reviews like this are invaluable in helping us to reflect and improve, and our focus remains on providing a high-quality education in a safe, supportive environment where every child can thrive.
